



SUMMARY OF DEMOCRATIC AUDIT BOUNDARY CHANGE SIMULATION

Lewis Baston, June 2011

This simulation considers the potential impact of changes to constituency boundaries to be drawn up by the Boundary Commissions for England, Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland. This simulation provides an indication of the extent to which existing constituency boundaries will need to change and a broad indication of the likely partisan effects.

The four Boundary Commissions, which are fully independent of government and the political parties, will issue their proposals from September 2011 onwards. At least some of the local detail of the proposals to be published by the Boundary Commissions will inevitably differ from that published here.

However, given the rules to be applied, the clear regional impacts of seat reductions, and existing geographical concentrations of Labour and Conservative support, the party political impacts of the Boundary Commissions' proposals are unlikely to vary considerably from our findings.
